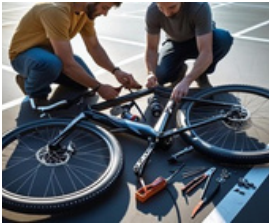
Your donation strengthens Power Pak & Blessing Box Food Support, meeting neighbors exactly where they are.
