## THANK YOU, CHRIST EPISCOPAL

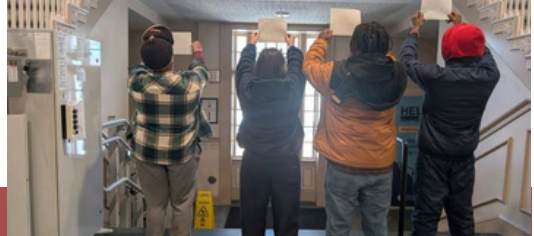
We are in tears of joy today!
